About Portsmouth, NH

Portsmouth has been a focal point for the New Hampshire seacoast since the 1600s when settlers used sailing barges called gundalows to ferry goods from the inland waters of Great Bay and trading ships came from around the world.

Today the city is a vital economic center for the region with a densely-built modern center that retains many of the classic brick buildings from the early 1800s. The downtown offers exceptional opportunities for shopping, dining, and entertainment.

Directions:

From the South: I-95 north to Exit 7; at the base of the exit, turn right, and proceed through traffic light. The road will fork slightly, stay to the left and follow to stop sign. Right at stop sign onto Hanover St. - right onto High St. Follow and turn left onto Garden Way.

From the North: I-95 South to Exit 7 in New Hampshire. at base of exit turn left. Proceed through 2 lights, road will fork slightly, stay to the left and follow to stop sign. Right at stop sign onto Hanover St. - right onto High St. Follow and turn left onto Garden Way.
